The club house will remain locked and you WILL need a key to get in. No one is going to open up for you!

#### SIGN IN FOR SHOOTING

Please remember to sign in when you are using the rifle, pistol, skeet or trap ranges on days when the club is not open, i.e. Tuesday evening and Sundays. Sign in skeets are located at the Rifle range, in the indoor pistol range, in the skeet low houses and in the trap house.

#### **SUNDAY WORKDAYS**

If you want to reduce your club dues you can do so by working on Sundays from 10AM to 3PM for the months April thru December. If so, please sign up on the work calendar in the clubhouse

You are responsible for working that date or finding your replacement. All full members must have one Sunday workday (6 hours) and six other work hours to be eligible for dues discount. DON'T JUST DROP THIS RESPONSIBILITY ON SOMEONE ELSE.

#### **REMINDER**

When shooting at the rifle/outdoor pistol range, shoot only from the benches.

Remember to put out the RED FLAG when going out in front of the shooting benches.
