INDOOR WINTER PISTOL LEAGUE

The pistol league will start Tuesday, January 3rd. The league will run twelve weeks with the final targets due no later than April tenth to allow for makeups.

Tuesday nights will be run by Randy Tomac npjrc@hotmail.com and Thursday nights will be run by Gary Milick mulick@gmail.com

The league will cost \$35.00 per gun. Once you are signed up you will be furnished twelve targets identified for each week of the league. They will be kept on top of the filing cabinet next to the fireplace.

The course of fire for the league will be ten shots per target. All ten shots will be fired and then the target can be scored and turned in. During league nights once targets are shot, they will be passed to another shooter to be scored. When scoring a shot that is tangent to the outside of the scoring ring will be the value of the higher scoring ring. Each target will have the maximum scoring capability of 100-10X. X's are counted as a ten as well as counted.

Each target will be verified before entering into the league record log, then posted at the club. The targets can be shot one or two handed but can't be supported during firing. Practice targets will be available for five for a dollar.

NICS CHECKS

The ATF/FBI has made some changes regarding the use of Concealed Carry Permits in lieu of a NICS background checks. To make it short, ALL firearms purchases through an FFL dealer MUST have a NICS background check! All non-FFL dealer transaction rules will remain as before.

ALSO, I HAVE BEEN INFORMED BY NICS THAT 10-20 YEAR OLD COMPLETING FORM 4473, THE NICS CHECK WILL BE DELAYED.

RIFLE RANGE

There is a donation box near the pole barn door. Please feel free to donate to it. The club has to pay for repairs and maintenance of the target backboards and your donations WILL help to keep your dues from increasing.

The Rifle Range rules are posted at the rifle range. Please read them and adhere to them.

The target boards get heavily damaged by constant normal use. We try to keep them in good repair, but we need more help. If you are

willing to assist, please contact a club officer.

Please put your target **BELOW THE RED BOARD.**

If you want to pattern your shotgun, please use the pattern board located at the east side of the trap range.

No shotguns on the rifle/pistol range except for slug guns.

If there are other shooters at the rifle range, please try to be courteous to them, i.e. give them the opportunity to set out targets or change targets, don't let your brass fly in front of the other shooters. You don't want to have someone's brass flying in front of your face, hitting you or worse yet having a hot semi-auto round go down your neck. So, please, don't do it to others.

ALSO, THIS IS NOT A TACTICAL SHOOTING RANGE! DO ALL YOUR SHOOTING FROM THE CONCRETE PADS.

Pick up your trash PLEASE!!!

If you must drive to the 100 and 200 yard backstops, watch out for the SOFT sand. The sand is very soft and fine in front of both 100 and 200 yard backstops. Proceed with caution unless you want to call a tow truck in addition to cleaning up your mess.

Please remember **NO ALCOHOL** on the shooting ranges.
