Rifle Range Sundays & Tuesday Evenings. Daily 9AM-dusk. Skeet/Trap Tuesdays 6PM-9PM Sunday 10AM-3PM Club house, skeet, trap, and indoor pistol ranges are open only to people who have keys. Rifle Range open to members who have keys.

SIGN IN FOR SHOOTING

Please remember to sign in when you are using the rifle, pistol, skeet or trap ranges on days when the club is not open, i.e. Tuesday evening and Sundays. Sign in sheets are located at the Rifle range, in the indoor pistol range, in the skeet low houses and in the trap house.

SUNDAY WORKDAYS

If you want to reduce your club dues you can do so by working on Sundays from 10AM. If so, please sign up on the work calendar in the clubhouse.
